## **1. Introduction**

## **2. Primary Care Workstream Group (November 2018)**

### **2.1 Primary Care Work programme highlight reports**

Reports highlighting areas of concern (i.e. schemes that had been RAG rated as amber or red in the workplan) were provided to PCWG. These issues were discussed individually with actions agreed to progress where appropriate.

## **3. Performance Monitoring**

### **3.1 Contractual Issues/Information**

No contractual issues were raised/discussed.

### **3.2 Contractual changes processed by NHSE (Appendix 1)**

Information provided by NHS England was submitted to the Primary Care Workstream Group and is appended to this report for information.

### **3.3 Primary Care Quality Visits Update**

A review of the primary care quality visit process was undertaken in May 2018 aimed at streamlining the programme by focusing on a suite of relevant data in line with CCG priority targets.

Prior to each visit, the Practice are issued with an Action Plan outlining their performance against the revised dashboard measures. During the visits, the Action Plans are agreed and target areas for improvement are documented, providing the Practices with deadlines for completion. Visits have been ongoing with the final one for 18/19 taking place on 4<sup>th</sup> February 2019.

## **5. Special Allocation Scheme (SAS) Up-date**

The group were provided with an update around the Special Allocation Scheme which is now following a more robust processes due its recent review. Learning and recommendations around the process will come back to Primary Care Workstream at a future date.

## **6. QinPC Phase 4 Project Plan**

The up-dated action plan was presented to the group.

## **7. NHS Health Checks Invite Targets October 2018**

The NHS Health Check programme is a public health programme in England for people aged 40-74 which aims to keep people well for longer. It is a risk assessment and management programme to prevent or delay the onset of diabetes, heart and kidney disease and stroke.

The purpose of this paper was to inform the PCWG on the redistribution of NHS Health Check invite targets for GP Practices in 2018/19.

## **8. Sector Meetings/Sector Leads**

The group were informed of the agreement for Sector Meetings to formally move over to the LCA from January 2019. Discussions are ongoing regarding the roles of Sector Leads.

## **9. Q2 LCS Report**

A quarter 2 performance report for the Locally Commissioned Services was discussed. A number of practices received notification of performance concerns as at Q1 and this will be repeated for Q2.

Overall, practices have made strong progress at the 6 month mark and had shown improvement within those areas highlighted within the Q1 notifications as well as across the contract. There was a small number of practices that had shown minimal (in some cases no) progress and are at risk of financial penalties being applied both in terms of having front funding recouped. A meeting is to be arranged between Primary Care and Finance on how this is taken forward.

## **10. Remedial Action for Practices in Relation to AKI Component of QIPC Contract 17/18**

A report was presented to the PCWG and a discussion held regarding the AKI Component of the QIPC Contract 17/18 which practices have already received payment for.

It was agreed that evidence of remedial action was required by practices were fewer than 90% of AKI discharge summaries have been recorded on patients' clinical records. Practices were to be contacted, with a deadline of 31<sup>st</sup> January 2019. It would also be indicated to the practice that failure to provide a satisfactory completed return by the deadline may result in the QIPC funding element that was predicated on the AKI work being rescinded.

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### 1.3 APMS update position

This information was presented previously and remains unchanged. Procurement successfully concluded for two APMS sites, Moorgate and Radcliffe. One contract awarded for service provision across both sites with effect from 1st April 2017. This will be provided by Rock Healthcare, on a 10 year term with an option to extend for a further 5 years with funding equitable to GMS. The database merge for the contracts has now been finalised and are operating under The Rock Y02755)

### 1.4. Remedial breach notices

There have been no remedial or breach notices issued during the reporting period.

### 1.5 CQC update

There have been no published CQC reports issued during the reporting period.

### 1.7 Direct Enhanced Services
