The options of implementing the contract within the context of the current Covid-19 pandemic also explored.	Approved the business case for the Quality in Primary Care Contract for 2020-2023; Confirmed the financial envelope for the Quality in Primary Care Contract; Confirmed support for Option 2 in the report which was to extend the time period for the development of the action plans until the end of September 2020. This provides additional time for the development of the plans so they can be produced when hopefully the impact of the pandemic has lessened. There was a risk that this time period may need to be extended.
