

Covid 19 Vaccination Update to SCB 1/2/21

- 4 Community Hub sites are operational – Prestwich, Radcliffe, Bury, Ramsbottom.
- Over 32,000 vaccinations delivered by 31/1/21 in these centres – 30,000 overwhelmingly first doses
- Vaccination workforce availability and booking arrangements continue to strengthen.
- Health and Care Staff hub at Fairfield General Hospital – over 3000 delivered.
- Additional capacity at Etihad – Bury resident take up not yet reported
- Older peoples care homes staff and residents offered vaccination by target date of 22/1/21
- Other Care Home staff and residents to be offered vaccination by mid February
- Housebound patient programme commenced w/c 24/1/21.
- Estimate of size of top 4 cohort size is 39,500 and we are on course to deliver that by mid Feb deadline.
- Mitigations in place for consequence of booking link for staff becoming publicly available
- Evidence emerging of differential take up, particularly ethnicity. Inequality action plan in development. Positive meeting with Muslim Community leadership on 27/1/21.
- Vaccine availability has been sufficient for our needs – national allocation determined by progress on cohort 1-4 achievement so potentially fewer vaccines delivered in coming weeks until we can commence with cohort 5/2nd doses.
- Planning underway for challenge of maintaining momentum through cohorts 5-8 while commencing delivery of second dose.
- Improving access to nationally held business intelligence to support the programme but further progress to be made.
- Continuing with comms programme including launch of Bury “vaccinometer” graphic on 27/1
